Arts and Trauma Healing

ONLINE 15 January 2020 **INTENSIVE** 22 March – 2 April 2020



A graduate-level course taught at All Nations and delivered in partnership with Dallas International University and the Trauma Healing Institute based in America. The course begins online in January with readings and assignments followed by a ten-day intensive at All Nations. It combines Biblical truths with basic mental health principles expressed in ways that can be easily translated into other languages. It will emphasise the importance of performing and visual arts in trauma healing. It fosters a holistic interactive approach, engaging Scripture within the healing process for people who suffer from the mental, emotional and spiritual effects of trauma. On successful completion you will be recognised as a Certified Apprentice Facilitator with the Trauma Healing Institute with the possibility of further training.
